

China's Carbon Emissions Report 2015

China's carbon emissions from fossil fuel burning and cement production were 8.50 Gt CO₂ in 2012, making it the country with the largest emissions in the world. China's carbon emissions were only 5.46 Mt CO₂ in 1950, thus the total emissions increased more than 100-folds during those 60 years. Such a growth rate was the highest among the world's major economies.
